The MENA region is rich in solar resources, which harnessed through technologies such as Concentrating Solar Power (CSP) and Thermal Energy Storage (TES) could help countries in the region meet their growing energy needs with clean power.

However, some obstacles remain in the implementation of this technology, including lack of awareness amongst some stakeholders. The <u>MENA CSP KIP web-based information platform</u> aims to tackle this by providing high quality information on CSP technology, project finance, and the value of CSP as part of the energy mix. A distinctive feature of this platform is that much of the information is presented in Arabic and French languages, as well as English, extending the reach of this website amongst readers across the MENA region.

The platform also serves as a point of contact between MENA CSP KIP industry experts and government officials and others who are exploring whether to add CSP plants to the power generation fleet.
